## Happy Mother's Day

Mother's Day was first suggested in 1872 by Julia Ward Howe (who wrote the words to the Battle Hymn of the Republic) as a day dedicated to peace. Ms. Howe would hold organized Mother's Day meetings in Boston, MA every year.

In 1907, Ana Jarvis from Philadelphia, began a campaign to establish a national Mother's Day. Ms. Jarvis persuaded her mother's church in Grafton, West Virginia to celebrate Mother's Day on the second anniversary of her mother's death, the 2nd Sunday of May. By the next year Mother's Day was also celebrated in Philadelphia.

Ms. Jarvis and her supporters began to write to ministers, businessmen, and politicians in their quest to establish a national Mother's Day. It was successful, as by 1911 Mother's Day was celebrated in almost every state. President Woodrow Wilson, in 1914, made the official announcement proclaiming Mother's Day as a national holiday that was to be held each year on the 2nd Sunday of May.

Although the honoring of mothers in present-day society is a recent practice, the Holy Scriptures have encouraged such behavior since the beginning of time. One doesn't need to read very far into the Bible to see this principle underlined over and over.

May we all take the appropriate time today to reflect on the blessing of motherhood and its significance in all of our lives. Use the time afforded us all today, for the purpose of honor, to express the befitting and proper thankfulness for God's wonderful gift of mothers.
